Canzian described the experience of developing a white-labelled wholesale version of BT Virtual Data Centre On Demand. Key highlight: "Analysts say our differentiator is our strong central platform and solid professional services organisation," Canzian said.

Challenges and Opportunities in Emerging Markets was the theme of a presentation by Tim Gigg, Head of International Transport Programmes, Vodafone Group, focusing particularly on Africa where mobiles outnumber fixed line users while capacity has been limited both in-country and to the outside world. Key highlight: "When it comes to cloud, Africa will leapfrog and learn from the mistakes we've made in Europe," Gigg said.
