CENX Opens Five New Exchanges

CENX ([News - Alert](#)), the company that pioneered Carrier Ethernet exchanges, is opening five new exchanges in London, Frankfurt, Hong Kong, Miami and New Jersey. Although each exchange provides the same level of service, they also match specific local and regional demands. CENX's two European exchanges, London and Frankfurt, are part of the strategic partnership with Interxion ([News - Alert](#)), a leading provider of colocation data center services in Europe, with 28 centers in 11 countries. This enables the rapid pan-European deployment of Carrier Ethernet exchanges.

Kevin Dean ([News - Alert](#)), chief marketing officer of Interxion, commented, "CENX's deployment of its proprietary Carrier Ethernet interconnect technology enables the exchange and management of Carrier Ethernet, voice, video, IP and content delivery all with a single efficient high-bandwidth connection That creates a very compelling business model for our co-located customers."

Nan Chen, president of CENX, remarked, "The marketplace acceptance of the CENX has been tremendous, with nine exchanges deployed in less than 12 months. We believe that this acceptance has been driven by the pent-up demand for services that support all attributes of Carrier Ethernet, including sophisticated service integration and monitoring as well as carrier-neutrality. This reflects our focus on serving, not competing, with our members."
