


Wireless Devices Going Through the Roof



- Smartphones doubling by 2017; tablets tripling
- But are they finding their way into enterprise networks?



The Answer Is a Resounding "Yes"




- From recent Infonetics survey
- Mobile devices growing fastest
 - 1/3 of devices today, growing to almost
 1/2 by 2014
- Meanwhile, desktops are declining...
- ...and the number of devices per user is going up



Meanwhile, Device Ownership Is Changing

- Traditionally, companies issued and controlled the devices employees use
- Now: A majority allow employees to bring their own devices (BYOD)
- Only 25% say they will not allow BYOD by 2014


Enterprises: Do You Allow BYOD?
