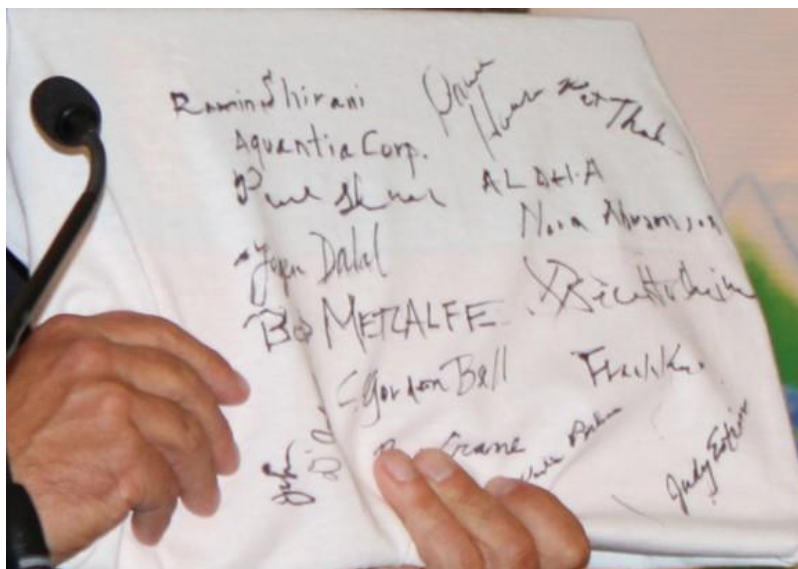
Bob Metcalfe pays \$ 20,000 for a shirt

The auction, held in Mountain View during a gala dinner and conference culminating celebration of 40th anniversary of Ethernet , was intended to raise funds for the American educational project STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Math (STEM)). Between auctioned objects, one of the most attention was a shirt signed by the co-founders on the Ethernet, Bob Metcalfe and Dave Boggs, apart from Norm Abramson, inventor of Aloha Net and Andy Bechtolsheim, among others.

NetEvents, event organizer, reports that during the auction, conducted among 300 attendees at the gala dinner raised a total of \$ 35,000.
